He completed his residency in Pediatrics and his fellowship in Pediatric Emergency Medicine at the Baylor College of Medicine’s affiliated hospital, Texas Children’s hospital. Dr. Sirbaugh lectures locally, statewide, regionally, and nationally on various topics related to Pediatric Emergency Medicine, especially as it relates to the field of Prehospital Pediatric Medicine. He is the national Chair of the EMS Subcommittee as well as a member of the Committee on Pediatric Emergency Medicine for the American Academy of Pediatrics, and is involved in various other local, statewide, regional, and national committees related to pediatric emergency medicine and prehospital pediatrics.
