MCI Committee: Steve Emerson reminded the Association that there was
some equipment currently stored in the MCI trailers that is due to expire in

CQI –UPDATE:

Each dept was asked to develop and submit a listing of Measurable Outcome for their Dept. Dave Dvorsky shared the County Wide Measurable Outcomes requested by Dr. Huss. Our Medical Director

They are as follows:

- The Department shall record time of page and out of door times for each call.
- The Department shall record the number of cardiac arrests they respond to.
- The Department will record the number of cardiac arrest patients that return to perfusion.

These three outcomes at a minimum must be included in all Department Measurable Outcomes. A discussion was had about how Dept. would track and document the results of these outcomes. Mindy Scott questioned if there was away to track the data on the JCEMS Website as well as possible improve the usefulness of the web site. It was mentioned that it would be nice to be able to do electronic enrollment for next year EMS Saturday Conference as well. Mindy Scott volunteered to follow up with Tracy Parizek (Website Designer) to see what options are available to the Association.

NEW BUSINESS:

HRSA Money Awarded = \$2172.00 this is a significant reduction from previous years. State is documenting what training money is being spent on. Key areas that are being measured are:

- 90% or EMS Providers are NIMS Compliant in ICS-700/100 & 200
- 90% are trained in START Triage Classes
- 90% are trained in Jump START Triage for Pediatrics.

They are asking Associations to provide

- # of Services
- Roster of EMS Personnel
- #People trained

HRSA Funds may also be used for any disaster related expenses such as supplies for the trailers/instructors.

Tim Hanson shared there is a great website to be used for the Triage classes it is called: jumpstarttirage.com
